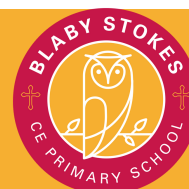

COMMUNITY

The school is well supported by its local community. We have a very active and welcoming PTA which organised lots of events over the year - from discos and colour runs to fetes and raffles. We have several reading volunteers who come and support the children every week, and we have close links with the local churches in Blaby. Every term we are invited to visit for different services and in turn, their Ministers visit school and take assembly. We also work to collect items for the local Food Bank and our children will often take part in national charity days and events.



Our School



Our school is located across two buildings, Headlands and Stokes, with vast playing fields and green spaces surrounding them. The younger children are based in Headlands, which gives them access to bespoke outdoor play equipment as well as spacious classrooms and facilities. Both sites have access to the internet and banks of laptops to use to support the curriculum. We have an onsite Forest School as well as plans to develop a sensory garden.

We provide a range of music, sport, science and craft clubs for our children to get involved in. Many of these are delivered by external companies or volunteers. We also offer a range of school trips and enrichment opportunities throughout the year.
